#### VIRTUAL REALITY

In calendar year 2021, 4 VR units were added to the Nursing Simulation Lab, providing new cutting-edge educational experiences for students, including learning to treat COVID-19 patients in virtual reality.

#### SHAPING NURSE LEADERS

Twenty graduating seniors participated in the fourth annual senior Leadership Academy. This free, not-for-credit program focuses on establishing a strong leadership philosophy and preparing newly graduated nurses to lead.

#### PROUD GRADUATES

PROUD, MCN's grant-funded initiative that provides financial assistance to nursing students from diverse or economically disadvantaged backgrounds, celebrated 10 PROUD students graduating in May 2021 and a further 5 graduates in August 2021. All 15 passed NCLEX.

#### GRANT-FUNDED INITIATIVE

The College received a \$2.8 million Health Resources and Service Administration (HRSA) grant in 2018 to launch the Change Agents to the Underserved Service Education (CAUSE) project. MCN is one of 42 universities nationwide and four universities in the state of Illinois to receive the four-year grant. The award amount for FY'22 was \$699,503.







# PASS RATES


MCN's NCLEX pass rate is consistently high. Our pass rate in 2021 was 96%, exceeding the state and national averages of 82% by a significant margin.

### ENROLLED STUDENTS




